

STOCK ITEM RECOMMENDATIONS FROM LAZY GIRL DESIGNS FOR GODDESS PATTERNS

The following are some product recommendations to use with our newest line of patterns. New in 2005, Lazy Girl Designs has taken on the world of embellishments and made them 'Lazy'. Starting with Chloe Handbag #LGD120 and Katy Bags #LGD121, our Goddess line emphasizes the use of OPTIONAL embellishments toward the goal of a more refined, upscale finished project. Embellishments can mean almost anything from fibers and buttons to beads and old jewelry. The following are items I work with and feel comfortable recommending. They are wonderful to use with all of our bag patterns. Other items may be suitable too.

| LAZY GIRL DESIGNS PATTERNS | | |

| LGD120 | Chloe Handbag – Uses 3 fat quarters. Fashion or fabric handles. Magnetic snap or Velcro closure. Retail \$9, min 1 | Full color patterns include template for placement of optional embellishments – fibers, buttons, and embroidery. |
| LGD121 | Katy Bags – Uses 2 fat quarters. One fashion or two fabric handles. Magnetic snap or Velcro closure. Retail \$9, min 1 | |
| LGD113 | Perfect Pouches – OPTIONAL Use this pattern to make a zippered pocket for inside - or outside - any of our bags. Make it in any size and leave out the batting. Then sew in place along the sides and bottom edges only. Leave the top edge free and that creates a pocket behind the pouch. | |
| RECOMMENDED SUPPLIES – HANDLES, CLOSURES, AND BATTING | | |
| 6241CV | Magnetic Snap - Clover ½" Black Nickel finish. Retail \$2.50, min 6 | 6241 Black Nickel finish is LGD's first choice - Blends well with many fabrics. 2 nd choice is 762_65 silver from Dritz. Note: ¾" size available, but size is too big and magnet is too strong for this size bag. |
| 6240CV | Magnetic Snap - Clover ½" Antique Gold finish. Retail \$2.50, min 6 | |
| 762_35 | Magnetic Snap - Dritz ½" gilt finish. Retail \$3.79, min 3 | Note: ¾" size available, but magnet is too strong for this size bag. |
| 762_65 | Magnetic Snap - Dritz ½" silver finish. Retail \$3.79, min 3 | |
| 6324CV | Handles – Clover black 'U' shaped, pair. Retail \$6.95, min 3 | Most 'U' shaped handles from these vendors will work. |
| 9820 | Handles – Dritz black 'U' shaped, pair. Retail \$5.99, min 3 | |
| 9700H | Batting - Armo Fleece Plus from HTC- bolt 45" x 25 yds, Retail \$3.25/yd. | Quilter's Dream and Warm & Natural are good choices too. |
| 90025V | Velcro – Beige, 5/8" x 12" SEW-ON. Retail \$1.49/ea, min 6 | Stock Beige and Black for most fabrics, use with most Lazy Girl patterns. Note: Don't use fusible/stick-on Velcro. |
| 90023V | Velcro – Black, 5/8" x 12" SEW-ON. Retail \$1.49/ea, min 6 | |
| 8531 | Asian Knot Cording - Black, thick in the 2 yard package from Clover Needlecrafts. Retail \$3.50. This is a wonderful solution for making a skinny shoulder strap for Katy. Variety of colors. Choose the thick rather than the thin cording. Braid, twist or knot several as an option. | |
| OPTIONAL GOODIES | | |
| Too many codes to list. | Adornaments fiber packs from EK Success – 48 color groupings to choose from. Retail \$6, min 3 Packs of 7 fibers, 3 ¼ yds per color. Stock 2 or 3 color groupings to coordinate with a fabric line to get started. Twist two strands together, zigzag stitch on top of fibers using monofilament thread of your choice. Use several strands to make a tassel. Pull through button holes for decoration. | |
| 809SRPWHT (use all caps for letters online) | Décor Bond fusible interfacing from Pellon. Retail \$2.90/yd. available by the bolt 44" x 25 yds. Listed as 'Optional' in supply lists on patterns. | Fuse to the lining fabrics of the Goddess bags to add a nice weight and stability to the project. |
| Buttons | Several vendors – Stock if you like. Patterns usually reference or show button embellishments. | |
| MY STUDIO BASICS | | |
| 505 | 505 Spray and Fix , J.T. Trading. Retail \$12.99/can, min 12. Spray is referenced in the patterns. | |
| 4002CV | Point Turner - Hera Marker from Clover. Retail \$5.75, min 6. (Not labeled for use as a point turner.) Many of our projects need to be turned right sides out. A hera marker has two wonderful tips to use for pushing out corners and side seams. Long seams have a tendency to buckle inward before pressed. Run the hera marker along the seam allowance from the inside once a project is turned right sides out before pressing with an iron. Use the flat end to 'finger' press. | |
| 720CV_1128 | Border Bias from Clover in Black. Border Bias, available in many colors, is 100% polyester, double fold, iron-on tape. It comes on a 6 yard spool and is 3/4" wide. Retail \$12.50, min 1. Not in our patterns – Always in my studio. Make tabs from fusible bias tape to attach handles to bags. Quick and easy. Sell by the yard from 6 yd roll. Use a 7" length, fold in half to measure 3 1/2" x 3/4" and press with an iron to fuse to itself. Then topstitch the edges to secure and you have almost instant handle tabs. Also, fold a really long piece in half so it's skinny, topstitch it and you have a spaghetti shoulder strap. Or, braid a few spaghettis to use as one strap. | |
| 469CV_BLUE 469CV_YLW | Chaco Liner from Clover – I can't say enough good things about this marking tool. Available in blue, pink, white and yellow. I use blue and yellow the most. Retail \$6.50, min 6 | |
