BLOCK ASSEMBLY Quilt consists of one 12" finished block repeated.

1. Take (1) C 1-1/2" x 2-1/2" rectangle and sew to sides of (1) B 2-1/2" square. Next add (1) C 1-1/2" x 4-1/2" rectangle to top and bottom of B-C unit. Make 24 BC units.

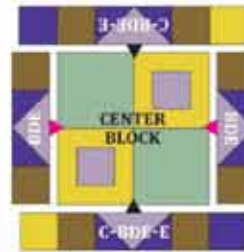
2. Sew (1) BC unit to left side of (1) A 4-1/2" square. Make 2. Then sew units together one on top of the other, with A on opposite sides, as shown in left diagram. Make 12 A-BC center blocks. Set aside.

3. FLYING GEESSE UNITS: Take (1) E 2-1/2" square and fold diagonally and press with iron or draw diagonal line on the wrong side (3a.). Next place E square on left hand side of (1) B 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" rectangle, right sides together and sew on diagonal line (3b.). Then press E open towards B top left corner. Trim excess fabric on reverse side to 1/4" (3c.). Repeat for right hand corner (3d.). Make 48 BE FLYING GEESSE units.

4. Sew (1) D 2-1/2" square to sides of EB FLYING GEESSE units. Note: direction of stripes and EB unit. Make 48 D-EB units. Set aside.

5. Sew (1) E 2-1/2" square to left side of (1) BDE unit and (1) C 2-1/2" square to right side. Make 24 E-BDE-C units.

Note direction of FLYING GEESSE units when assembling blocks.



6. Add (1) BDE unit to sides of CENTER BLOCK, from step 2.
7. To complete block add C-BDE-E unit to top and bottom of center block,
8. Square block to 12-1/2". Make 12 blocks.

QUILT ASSEMBLY Quilt consists of 4 horizontal rows. Refer to QUILT DIAGRAM for proper rotation of blocks.

9. Sew (3) blocks together, side to side. Make 4 rows. Then sew ROW 1 to ROW 2 and so forth.

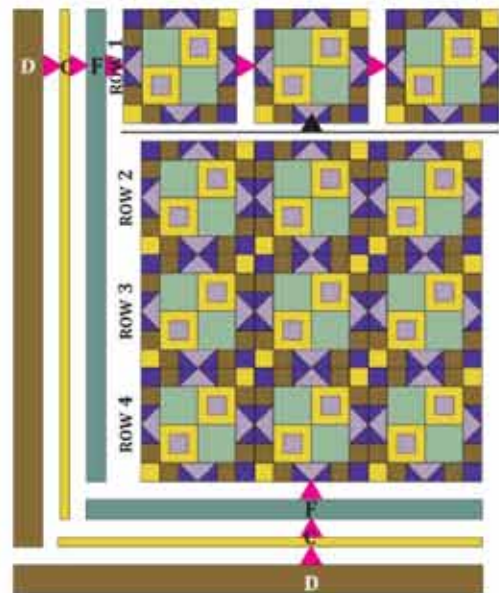
BORDER ASSEMBLY

INNER BORDER: Sew F 2-1/2" x 48-1/2" strips to sides of quilt top. Next add F 2-1/2" x 40-1/2" strips to top and bottom.

SASHING: Sew C (for olive) or E (for rust) 1-1/2" x 52-1/2" strips to sides of quilt top. Then add C or E 1-1/2" x 42-1/2" strips to top and bottom.

OUTER BORDER: Sew D 3-1/2" x 54-1/2" strips to sides of quilt top. Then add D 3-1/2" x 48-1/2" strips to top and bottom.

QUILT DIAGRAM



FINISHING Cut batting and backing 3" larger than top on all sides. Assemble the quilt sandwich by placing the backing, batting and top together in layers and baste or pin with safety pins. Machine quilt as desired. When quilting is completed, trim excess batting and backing. Bind in the usual manner.

FINISHED SIZE: 48" x 60".

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
